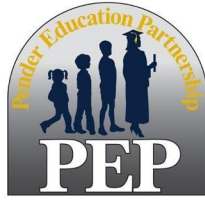
One \$1000 and one \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student at each of the district's high schools – Heide Trask High School, Pender Early College High School, Pender High School, Pender Innovative Learning Academy and Topsail High School.

To be eligible for this scholarship, students must be a graduating senior at one of Pender County's five high schools and plan to attend a PUBLIC community college, four year college/university or a trade school in North Carolina.

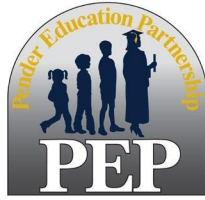
