



Jones- Trawick Scholarship

In 1969, Jerome Calvin Jones graduated from Burgaw High School, which had been recently integrated. He went on to attend and earn a bachelor's degree from East Carolina University. This scholarship honors his character and the dignity with which he handled being integrated from an all-black school to a predominantly white school.

Eligibility:

- Be a graduating senior of **minority descent** currently enrolled at one of the five Pender County Public High Schools
- Demonstrate financial need (include a copy of your FAFSA)
- Academic excellence (minimum weighted GPA of 3.0 for high school)
- Be accepted to attend a four-year accredited college or university (can be in or out of state, public or private).
- Please include a copy of your letter of acceptance from college/university.
